Edible Guernsey Partnership

Wigwam has just had some fabulous news. We are working in partnership with Edible Guernsey to build a play area specifically for children with additional needs. It will be adapted to make it a safe and interesting place where parents and carers can take their children. It is adapted so that parents and carers can sit at one end with a cup of coffee and see their children from every angle. This has been specially designed so that parents can relax and don't have to follow their children around to prevent climbing, throwing etc.

Edible Guernsey have donated the space in their community greenhouse in St Peters (just down the road from Le Rondin school)

In addition, there will be opportunities for the whole family to learn how to grow their own food and for children to plant seedlings and see them develop. Many of our young people with a learning disability go on to employment in horticulture so it is particularly good to be able to encourage an interest in plants early for children.

Last week, we received a donation for the entire amount that we need to build the play area. The money has been donated by a wonderful woman who has given this grant from a fund left by her late husband. Although she wishes to remain anonymous, I'm sure you join me in thanking her for making this play area possible.

Our next step is to get formal plans drawn up and then start the building work.
